Saint Peter's Episcopal Church is a vibrant and living member of the world-wide Anglican Communion. Founded in 1822, we are firmly grounded in our historic roots yet actively growing with our vision. Our Anglican connections make us ever cognizant that we are connected to a world beyond our stone walls. I believe once you explore our website you will discover that as a parish family we are committed to living out during the week what we say on Sunday mornings.

I hope that you will join us for worship. When you do, you will find a parish family who is welcoming, engaging, and friendly. Worship at Saint Peter's is Eucharistically centered and represents the broad liturgical traditions of the Episcopal Church. The 8 a.m. service is Rite I with a reflective, simpler tone. The 10:15 a.m. service is Rite II with traditional choral and contemporary music, and is a more exuberant experience. Christian Formation programs are offered for ages 4 to 104 at 9:15 a.m. during the school year. A nursery is available.

Occupying the original lot set aside in 1776 by the town founder for a place of worship, Saint Peter's has always played an active role in the community. Not only are the historic graveyard and buildings a popular tourist stop, the people of Saint Peter's participate in the life of the greater community through activities such as our annual Free Dental Clinic, Stop Hunger Now, excellent Lenten Programs, Upward youth basketball league, Hispanic ministries, Toys for Tots distribution center, Blood Drive, Vacation Bible School, and more.

Saint Peter's also serves the broader community through its excellent Day School, providing quality education for 2, 3, and 4 year olds in new, state of the art classrooms. Founded in 1954, generations of Washingtonians have been shaped by and well-prepared for their future by an outstanding cadre of teachers.
